Enjoy your summer. Visit the Episcopal Church

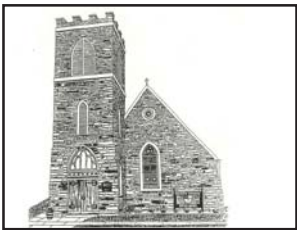
