June Highlights

June 8 - Day of Pentecost. We have just celebrated Ascension, when Jesus' disciples see him rise to heaven; but he promises he will not leave them alone, and will send a helper, the comforter, to them. Sometimes called "The Birthday of the Church," Pentecost commemorates the coming of the Holy Spirit to the apostles, the power Jesus promises them to be his witnesses. It is also one of the days set aside for Baptism; if there are no baptisms on this day, we take part in renewing our own Baptismal Vows. It's a day of celebration .. Join us .. And wear something **RED**.



June 15: Trinity Sunday. Celebrate our name day with us. There are great hymns

for the day, the ones you remember from your childhood. Also, Fr. Ben will be out of town that day and Mtr. Trula will be celebrating, and **vestry meets**. As always, everyone is welcome to stay after coffee hour and join the meeting.

Outreach discretionary fund: We no longer have a rector's discretionary fund, a small account that was used for emergency help to those in real need. The vestry proposes that we reestablish this fund. If you wish to make a contribution, you may write a check and indicate its purpose on the *for* line. There are now also envelopes in each pew for cash donations.

2014 ECW Project: This year items will be collected in support of the ministry at St. George's Regional Disaster Recovery and Outreach Center. Items needed include:

- First Aid supplies -- adhesive bandages, gauze pads and tape (no creams or other items with expiration dates)
- Personal care items - toothbrushes and paste, washcloths, bar soap, razors
- Evacuation "Go Kits" - individual tissue packets, hand wipes, space blankets, rain ponchos
- Also: Single flat bed sheets and pillow cases; white socks, large plain sweatshirts, NRSV Bibles, children's packets (activities, crayons, etc.), notes of encouragement for kits.

All items are used to provide emergency resources in times of natural disasters, for preparedness in disaster-prone areas, and to help those who struggle with life's every-day storms and trials. Diocesan Convention is October 10 and 11.
