### May Highlights

#### May 17: Vestry meets.

**May 24: Day of Pentecost.** Sometimes called "the birthday of the church," Pentecost commemorates the coming of the Holy Spirit, the Comforter, thus empowering the early church to embark on the Great Commission. Originally called Whitsunday, it is also a day when Baptism is particularly appropriate; if there is no baptism on this day, there is a reaffirmation of our baptismal vows. Be sure to join us and remember to wear something **RED**.

**May 31: Trinity Sunday.** It's our name day and the beginning of the season after Pentecost, a time of growth and learning, which will continue through the end of the church year, which is the last Sunday before Advent begins next November 29.

### Vestry News

Work on the apse, the area around the altar, was delayed, but should begin this coming week. This will mean there will likely be scaffolding in place for a few weeks while the crumbling and peeling plaster is scraped, patched, and repainted. Money for this project was set aside last year and carried forward into the 2015 budget.
