March 20 - Palm Sunday
Our service will include the reading of the Passion, with the entire congregation taking part. Weather permitting, we will process to the church door.

March 24 - Maundy Thursday The day Christ instituted the new rite: Holy Eucharist II and Stripping of the altar, 7 p.m.

Saturday, March 26, Holy Saturday. The Great Vigil and First Eucharist of Easter, 7 p.m. This is the most ancient and beautiful of services in the church year. We begin in darkness and kindle a new fire. The readings trace the history of God's people and

culminate in the joyous celebration of the Resurrection. We are extending an invitation to members of all denominations in the community to join us.
