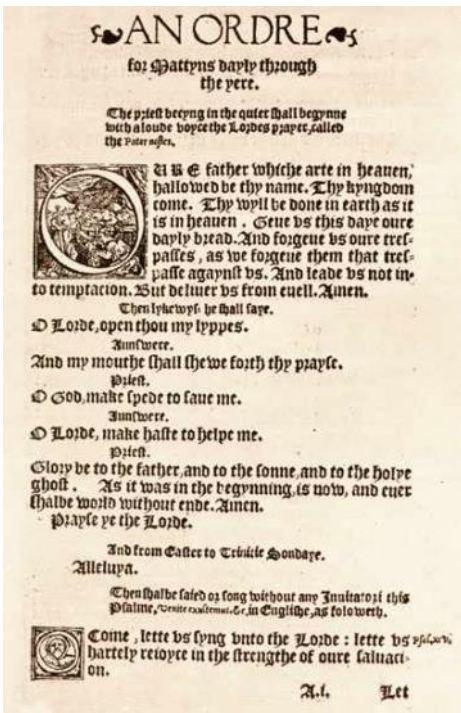

We are pleased to be planning a really nice service of Morning Prayer, Rite I, on the 8th. Our organist, Joe Barber, is very familiar with the office settings. You probably remember the *Venite*, *Jubilate*, *Te Deum* and more from your childhood. We haven't sung any of these in many, many years, but we will on July 8.

So, please plan to join us!

Our own **Mthr. Hazel Hunt** will be with us to preach and celebrate on the 15th. You may remember that she was a member of Trinity for many years and that part of her discernment process involved members of Trinity. It's always good to have her with us.

Our roster of **Worship Leaders and Lectors** has gotten shorter and shorter. If you would like to be a lector (read the Old Testament Lesson), we'd welcome you warmly. We can also arrange to train you to be a Worship Leader (formerly called Lay Reader). At this time we have only three licensed Worship Leaders, which makes scheduling tight. Please, talk to Barbara if you are interested in helping with these wonderful ministries that add so much to our corporate worship together.

During the summer we use the **service music** (the *Gloria* and *Sanctus*) from the supplement to the hym-

nal, *Wonder, Love and Praise*. We've been doing this for several years and it's very popular. If you look at the front of each of those books, you'll find they were given in memory of Sally Ward.



**The 79th General Convention of the Episcopal Church** will be held from July 5th to the 13th in Austin, Texas. This year, for the first time, the giant notebooks full of paper hauled around by every deputy will be replaced by online re-

sources. That's been a long time coming. For those of us who will not be there, we can follow along on our home computers or with a new app on any of our devices. There are two ways to get the app: Go to <https://eventmobi.com/79gc> to open the app as a website on any device. Or search for "Eventmobi" in the appstore or on Google Play, install it, then open the Eventmobi app and enter the event code: 79gc. Worship (and business) will be live-streamed. The bulletins are already available at the [generalconvention.org](http://generalconvention.org); click on worship. Our Presiding Bishop, Michael Curry, will preach at the revival service on July 7. 
