**Buildings and Grounds.** It's been a good year for the **church garden.** There's been enough rain that Barbara has only had to water a few times, which helps her water bill! There will

be some fall work to do on it to prepare for Spring. Our Junior Warden, Nate Schwartzberg, has re-anchored the **railings to the sacristy door**, which will make going in that way a lot safer. He and Senior Warden, Dan Gerhart, will be working on the **tracery over the front doors** soon, which will likely involve a scaffold, which you might see as you drive by. We've just had our 1902 **Hook and Hastings organ** evaluated by Parsons. They will be sending us an estimate to replace the springs on the swell (lower keyboard) which has become difficult to play. Overall, the organ is in good shape for its age. Thanks to our organist, **Joe Barber**, for being there to translate! We are also looking into replacing the **vinyl letters on the church sign**; the current ones are faded.
