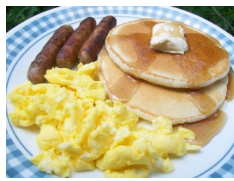

Sunday, March 3 - The Last Sunday After The Epiphany. We sometimes call this *Alleluia Sunday*, as it's the last time we'll be saying or singing alleluia until Easter.
